

This work symbolizes the constant flow of energy throughout the pipeline that Texas Gas Transmission LLC maintains.

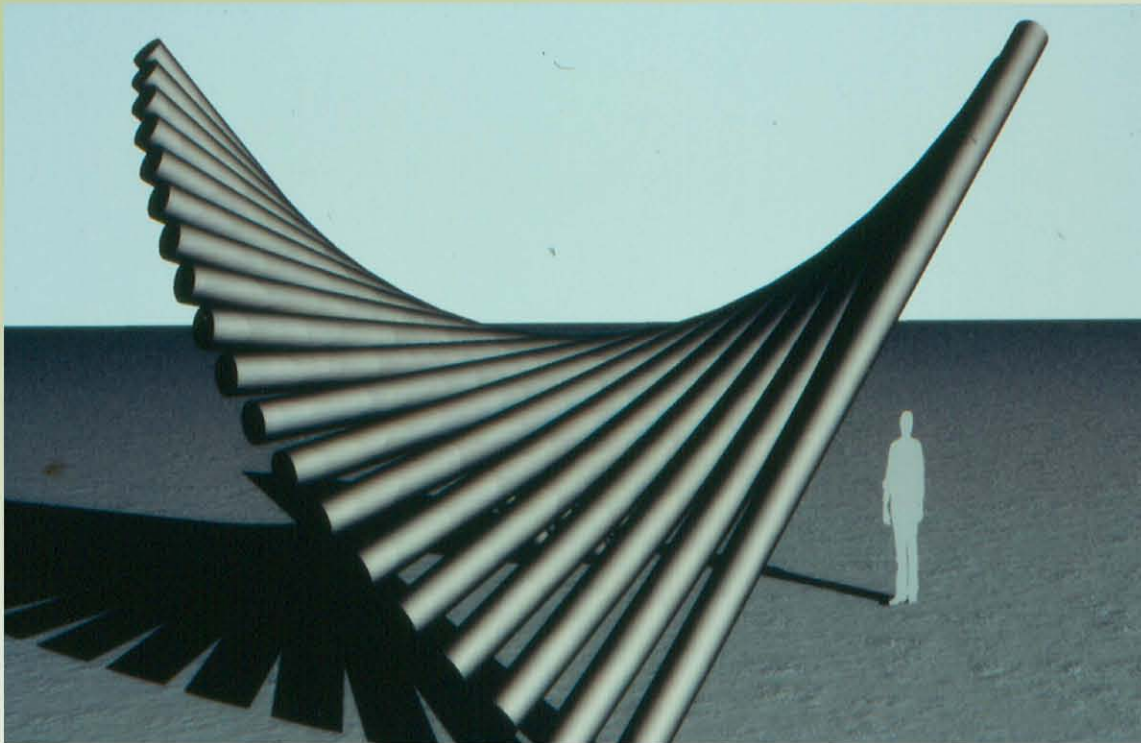
